This program allows charitable  
organizations to generate limitless  
contributions based on the number of  
"birdies" made by LPGA Players during  
the tournament. There is no limit to  
the number of charities that can  
participate and the monies generated  
by participating organizations will go  
directly to the group soliciting the  
pledge. A "birdie" is a score of one  
stroke better than "par." The average  
number of birdies made by  
professionals at any LPGA Tournament  
is 1400. Charities must solicit pledges  
of \$.01 or more per birdie or a flat  
donation of \$10 or more from an  
individual or corporation. Each  
participating charity will receive 100  
percent of their collected donations.
